Planet Aid wishes to address head-on the unfounded allegations in NBC's recent stories.

These stories have alleged that Planet Aid is part of a global network that funnels money to Mogens Amdi Peterson, who was accused by Danish authorities of tax fraud more than 15 years ago.

None of the allegations against Planet Aid are true. Petersen has nothing to do with Planet Aid now, nor has he at any time in the past. Planet Aid was not founded by Petersen and Planet Aid's leadership has no financial or organizational links with him.

As a US incorporated 501(c)(3) non-profit corporation, all of our tax filings are public and receive close IRS scrutiny.

The money that Planet Aid receives from donations and from U.S. Government grants goes directly to support our development work around the globe. And as recipients of U.S. Government grants Planet Aid is subject to regular oversight by its donor organizations. We follow strict compliance measures to ensure that our finances meet or exceed those high standards.
