On 10/23/14, two (2) subjects were observed cashing out vouchers that did not belong to them. When approached by security and PPD, they returned the money and were evicted from the casino.

On 10/24/14, a subject cashed out a voucher valued at \$275.50 that did not belong to him. He was approached by security while attempting to cash it in. When questioned, he returned the voucher.

On 10/31/14, a patron reported to security that someone had stolen her leather coat.

Underage on casino floor: 3

On 10/6/14, a female child pulled away from her mother in the lobby area of the Prime Rib and ran under the barrier onto the gaming floor. She was immediately caught by security and returned to her mother.

On 10/12/14, a male child walked under the barrier and onto the gaming floor. The child was immediately observed by security and returned to the parents.

On 10/17/14, after being turned away at the north entrance for being underage, an underage female went to the east entrance and after showing identification to security

she was allowed to enter. She was detained a short time later and evicted. The female did not gamble or consume any alcohol.

On 10/19/14, a male subject who is enrolled in VEP was located on the gaming floor at table games Pit 2. His chips were recovered and he was charged with trespass.

Physical altercations: 3

On 10/3/14, a male subject became involved in a physical altercation with security personnel and was subsequently arrested by AACOPD.

On 10/11/14, two (2) male patrons became involved in a physical altercation with one being evicted.

On 10/22/14, two (2) male patrons become involved in a physical altercation.

Theft/Robbery: 3

On 10/10/14, a patron reported to security that someone had stolen \$800.00 in currency from him.

On 10/12/14, a patron reported to security that someone had stolen several dollars from her sweater pocket.

On 10/15/14, a patron reported to security that someone had stolen \$200.00 worth of chips from him while at a table. The suspect was identified and the chips were returned.

Employee theft: 2

On 10/13/14, a poker dealer was found to have been stealing contribution payments and placing them in his personal token (tip) box. The dealer was suspended pending investigation.

On 10/23/14, a female employee was short \$10,000.00 from her drawer in the cash cage. When interviewed, the employee became defensive and left the casino. The employee was suspended pending investigation by AACOPD.

On 10/12/14, a patron reported to security that someone had stolen \$50.00 she had left in the redemption kiosk. A male subject removed the money and was located at a VLT. The money was returned.

Horseshoe Casino

Underage on casino floor: 1

On 10/27/14, an underage male (16 years of age) was discovered exiting a restaurant with his father. A review by surveillance revealed that the underage subject entered the 2nd floor entrance, walked past three (3) security guards and was not challenged. The subject did not gamble or consume any alcohol.

Intoxicated patrons evicted: 15

On 10/5/14, a male patron in the poker room was identified as being too intoxicated to remain in the casino and was evicted.

On 10/5/14, a male patron was identified as being too intoxicated to remain on the gaming floor and was evicted.

On 10/5/14, a female patron in the poker room was identified as being too intoxicated to remain in the casino and was evicted.

On 10/8/14, a male patron was identified as being too intoxicated to remain on the gaming floor and was evicted. He left the property in a taxi.

On 10/8/14, security responded to one of the restaurants for a disorderly female and identified the subject as too intoxicated to remain in the casino. The female was evicted and left the property in a taxi.

On 10/10/14, a male patron was identified as being too intoxicated to remain on the gaming floor and was evicted.

On 10/11/14, a male patron was identified as being too intoxicated to remain on the gaming floor and was evicted. He left the casino with a friend.

On 10/11/14, a male patron was identified as being too intoxicated to remain in the poker room and was evicted.

On 10/12/14, an intoxicated subject was found passed out behind the wheel of his vehicle. BCP was notified and responded.

On 10/12/14, an unresponsive, intoxicated female subject was found lying in the women's restroom. EMS was called and the female was transported to an area hospital.

On 10/13/14, a male patron was identified as being too intoxicated to remain on the gaming floor and was evicted. He left the property in a taxi.

On 10/13/14, a male patron was acting disorderly in a restaurant. He was identified as being too intoxicated to remain on the gaming floor and was evicted. He left the property with his brother.

On 10/23/14, a female patron was identified as being too intoxicated to remain in the poker room and was evicted.

On 10/23/14, female patron was identified as being too intoxicated to remain in the gaming floor and was evicted. She left with a male friend in a taxi.

On 10/31/14, a male patron was identified as being too intoxicated to remain in the poker room and was evicted. He left with his girlfriend.

Physical altercations: 7

On 10/3/14, two (2) male subjects became involved in a physical altercation and were evicted.

On 10/4/14, a male and a female became involved in a physical altercation in the parking garage. The male was arrested by BCP and the female was transported to an area hospital.

On 10/5/14, two (2) male subjects became involved in a physical altercation and were evicted.

On 10/11/14, three (3) female subjects and one (1) male subject were involved in a physical altercation. All parties were evicted from the casino.

On 10/11/14, a male subject was caught stealing an item from the gift shop. The subject was evicted from the casino.

On 10/18/14, a female subject reported to security that a male subject had assaulted her and had some of her items in his possession. BCP investigated and the male subject was arrested for domestic assault.

On 10/18/14, four (4) male subjects were involved in two (2) separate physical altercations with other patrons and BCP. All subjects were evicted.

Theft/Robbery: 13

On 10/6/14, a male subject was identified as having stolen from the casino by capping his bets. When approached he attempted to flee the building but was detained by security in the garage. He was subsequently arrested by BCP.

On 10/6/14, a male patron met two (2) females while in the casino. Upon returning to his home with both females, they stole his wallet, jewelry and cell phone.

On 10/10/14, a patron reported to security that another male subject had stolen chips from him. The suspect was located at the cash cage at which time he reimbursed the victim for the loss.

On 10/10/14, security responded to a complaint of a male subject stealing food from a restaurant. The subject was located, restitution was made, and the subject was evicted from the casino.

On 10/12/14, a male subject was found to have stolen \$50.00 worth of chips from another patron. The subject refused to reimburse the money and was evicted from the casino.

On 10/11/14, a male subject was found to have broken into a vehicle in the parking garage. The subject was arrested by BCP.

On 10/12/14, a male subject tore a token (tip) box off of the wall near a men's restroom and took it inside. The token box was located in the restroom with all of the contents removed. The subject was identified however he had already left the casino.

On 10/14/14, a patron reported to security that someone had stolen her wallet. A suspect was identified and evicted.

On 10/18/14, a patron reported that she had lost her wallet containing \$152.00. A review by surveillance revealed that a male subject picked up the wallet and left the casino.

On 10/21/14, a patron reported to security that a gold coin valued at \$3,500 was missing from the console in his vehicle when he picked it up from valet.

On 10/25/14, a subject attempted to cash a duplicate voucher. The original had been handwritten due to a machine malfunction. The subject left without the money.

On 10/31/14 a subject took a voucher valued at \$140.00 that did not belong to her. She was confronted by security at which time she made restitution. The subject was evicted.

On 10/31/14, a male subject tried to exit the casino carrying a "cold" box that he had removed from the base of a machine prior to the drop.
