Underage on casino floor: 0

Intoxicated patrons evicted: 3

On 9/27/14, a male patron was identified as being too intoxicated to remain on the gaming floor and was evicted. He departed the property in a cab.

On 9/20/14, a two (2) male patrons were identified as being too intoxicated to remain on the gaming floor and were evicted.

On 9/27/14, a female patron was identified as being too intoxicated to remain on the gaming floor and was evicted. She was taken from the property by a friend.

Underage on casino floor: 1

On 9/17/14, an underage female subject was identified when she attempted to sign up for Live Rewards. She was allowed to enter the casino after two (2) security guards viewed her identification.

Intoxicated patrons evicted: 3

On 9/1/14, an intoxicated male subject was denied entry due to his condition. He became belligerent with security staff and AACOPD who were assisting, and was subsequently arrested.

On 9/22/14, a male patron was identified as being too intoxicated to remain on the gaming floor and was evicted. He was departed the property in a cab.

On 9/22/14, a male patron was identified as being too intoxicated to remain on the gaming floor and was evicted.

Children unattended in vehicles: 1

On 9/2/14, an adult male and female entered the casino and left two (2) children, one (1) and twelve (12) years of age, locked in an unattended vehicle in the parking garage. While conducting a check of the parking garage, security noticed the children and casino management was notified along with AACOPD. Investigation revealed that the children were left unattended for approximately thirty (30) minutes. AACOPD is conducting an investigation.

Physical altercations: 3

On 9/26/14, a male and a female became involved in physical altercation at Pit 9.

On 9/27/14, two (2) male subjects became involved in a physical altercation and were evicted.

On 9/27/14, a male and a female became involved in a physical altercation at the Live Rewards booth. Both were evicted.

Theft/Robbery: 13

On 9/3/14, a cashier notified security that a male subject reached into the cage and removed \$125.00 worth of chips. When the subject returned to the cage and cashed the chips in, he was detained and returned the \$125.00.

On 9/3/14, a patron reported to security that someone had stolen \$50.00 worth of chips from his position at a table in Pit 9.

On 9/3/14, a subject was identified as having stolen \$300.00 worth of chips from a roulette table. The subject left the casino prior to being identified.

On 9/18/14, a male subject was evicted for obtaining comp play off of another person's account.

On 9/20/14, a patron reported to security that a male subject had started playing a VLT she had previously been playing and cashed out her credits valued at \$75.00.

On 9/24/14, a patron reported to security that someone had stolen his cash voucher valued at \$465.80.

On 9/25/14, a patron reported to security that someone had stolen \$1,200.00 from her vehicle while it was parked in the garage.

On 9/27/14, a patron reported to security that someone had removed her purse from her vehicle while it was parked in the garage. AACOPD is investigating.

Horseshoe Casino

Underage on casino floor: 2

On 9/17/14, an underage male subject was located on the gaming floor. A review by surveillance revealed that the subject entered the casino through the second floor entrance. Once on the floor, the subject placed bets on the craps table and threw the dice. The subject was identified and was evicted from the casino.

On 9/19/14, a restaurant employee brought her small child to work and the child was located BOH with a visitor's badge. A security manager located them and the employee removed the child from the casino.

Intoxicated patrons evicted: 6

On 9/14/14, a male subject was evicted due to his apparent state of intoxication.

On 9/17/14, a male subject was identified as being too intoxicated to remain on the gaming floor and was evicted.

On 9/21/14, two (2) patrons were identified as being too intoxicated to remain on the gaming floor and were evicted.

On 9/21/14, a male patron was identified as being too intoxicated to remain on the gaming floor and was evicted.

On 9/28/14, two (2) female patrons were identified as being too intoxicated to remain on the gaming floor and were evicted.

On 9/30/14, a male patron was identified as being too intoxicated to remain on the gaming floor and was evicted. After several attempts to re-enter the casino, BCP became involved and he was escorted from the property.

Children unattended in vehicles: 1

On 9/5/14, two (2) minor children were found unattended in a running vehicle in the parking garage. Investigation revealed the children were only unattended for a few minutes prior to being located by security personnel. The parents were identified and found to be casino employees. BPD responded however there were no charges due to the children's age. No further investigation is needed.

Excluded persons in casino: 4

On 9/5/14, a male subject enrolled in the VEP was located on the gaming floor and was found to be playing table games.

On 9/12/14, a male subject enrolled in the VEP was located on the gaming floor and was found to be pinching bets while playing table games.

On 9/20/14, a male subject enrolled in the VEP was located on the gaming floor and was found to be playing table games.

On 9/24/14, a male subject enrolled in the VEP was located on the gaming floor.

Physical altercations: 5

On 9/19/14, two (2) male subjects were evicted in reference to a physical altercation.

On 9/19/14, a male subject was evicted in reference to a physical altercation.

On 9/20/14, a mother and daughter were evicted in reference to being involved in a physical altercation.

On 9/21/14, three (3) female subjects were involved in a physical altercation resulting in the arrest of two (2) of them.

On 9/28/14, a male subject was evicted for improper touching of a female beverage server.

On 9/30/14, two (2) female subjects were evicted in reference to being involved in a physical altercation.

Theft/Robbery: 2

On 9/1/14, a patron reported to security that someone had stolen a cash voucher from her purse while she was playing at a VLT.

On 9/22/14, a patron reported to security that someone had stolen \$175.00 worth of chips from his table location.

Employee theft: 2

On 9/19/14, a male casino employee was terminated for the theft of an undetermined amount of money from another casino employee's purse.

On 9/28/14, a security guard was found to have stolen \$2,000.00 worth of chips after signing them out from the cage. BCP was notified and is investigating.

Drugs: 1

On 9/14/14, a bartender found a small plastic bag containing a white powder type substance on the bar. Security was notified and the substance was turned over to BPD.
